





Per Rockford Homeowner's Association Handbook, all fencing will be six feet high from ground level, and all boards used will be dog-eared. It will be erected in the shadow-box form, and 1/2 x 6 inch cedar boards will be used. The fence will include a 48-inch gate, constructed the same as the fence. Brick pillars will anchor and support the fence. Brick pillars 1' x 1' with brick cap will be at all corners of the fence. The brick for the pillars should match the brick of the house as closely as possible. The addition of the brick pillars is required to keep the fence consistent with other fences in the Rockford neighborhood. Examples can be seen at 817 Rockford Lane, 809 Rockford Lane,) and 701 Rockford Drive. All brick pillars will be cemented in the ground. The fence will be set back on the property aligned with the front edge of the chimney, which is several feet back from the recessed front door.

Rockford Homeowner's Association Fencing Policy Adopted October 5, 2018

All fencing will be six feet high from ground level, and all boards used will be dog-eared. It will be erected in the shadow-box form, and 1/2 x 6 inch cedar boards will be used. The fence will include a 48-inch gate, constructed the same as the fence. Brick pillars will anchor and support the fence. Brick pillars 1' x 1' with brick cap will be at all corners of the fence. The fence will enclose only the back yard and be in alignment with the house. All fencing should be maintained in good working condition.
